Todd and Claudia Braschler currently reside in Wichita, KS and have since 1998. Both attending

Anderson University in Anderson, IN, they were raised in pastor's homes, and were married in 1985. Three boys were raised in their home, one pursuing ministry, one finishing college currently, and one still at home.

In 2001 Todd stepped out fulltime as a Christian artist and retreat speaker after 20 years as a worship pastor, investing in church leaders, men's ministries and couples. His background prepared him well in many ways having been raised in a family that sang in Branson, MO in a show called the Braschler Music Show. For 24 years, this family ministered in a very unique way in the entertainment industry. But his heart and passion continued for the church, and now offers him the joy of investing in people in a variety of ways. Todd writes “Instead of just getting busy as a pastor, I personally looked for ways to invest that brought the greatest gain. Biblical Foundation

God knew we would be busy people, easily distracted by the pace of our life and our priorities. One author writes “**If Satan can't make me fail, he'll just make me busy.**” How do we keep ourselves accountable to God's direction and vision in the midst of a hectic world and pace of life?

“Intentionally His” is simply an effort to help couples spend time articulating God's vision for them, to align their life and their marriage in a way that God



would bless what they do together. In the book of Habakkuk 2:2-3 we read a response to the question “**What do I do with God's vision for me?**”

*And then God answered: "Write this.
Write what you see.*

*Write it out in big block letters
so that it can be read on the run.*

*This vision-message is a witness
pointing to what's coming.*

*It aches for the coming—it can hardly wait!
And it doesn't lie.*

*If it seems slow in coming, wait.
It's on its way. It will come right on time.*

The Message

How fulfilling could your life be today if it were being lived out intentionally toward God's articulated vision, written down to refer to while on the run?

Retreat Content

This one, two or three-day retreat is comprised of the following challenges:

- **Aligning** our marriage with the anointing and blessing of God. Without his guidance, strength and wisdom, his vision will always be nothing more than a dream.
- **Understanding** the role vision should play in my life.
- **Articulating** God's vision for our marriage, our family, and personally, for you.
- **Setting** non-negotiable boundaries in areas of our marriage. Without these guidelines, we will never become the couple God sees.
- **Discerning** strategy to move us into God's vision, and realize his desire for our marriage.
- **Proclaiming** a family mission statement that connects our family with the power of the Holy Spirit.

The Retreat Consists of the Following:

- Teaching sessions.
- Personal time alone and with your spouse.
- Personal coaching opportunities with Todd.
- Fellowship with others at the retreat.
